



Host Compassion in Action Campfire for Domus Pacis Families

Organize a campfire, welcoming the Domus Pacis families visiting Summit County for their respite stays – only during the summer months. Each Wednesday night Domus Pacis is looking for a different service group like the Scout Troops, church youth groups, school activity clubs, neighborhood families, etc. that could volunteer to plan and host our families for a campfire.

Objective:

- Provide an opportunity for Summit County’s families and youth to share the blessings of being in the mountains every day.
- Give parents an avenue to teach their children compassion.
- Broaden Domus Pacis’ awareness about how an entire family is greatly affected when a family member is ill.
- Permit our Domus Pacis families to feel and see the kindness of our community.
- Allow our kids and community members to know that their service REALLY matters!

Process:

- Commit to one specific week starting the first week of June.

- Communicate what your group is capable of providing, i.e. wieners, buns, condiments, salads, drink, s’mores, etc.
- Provide the list of adults and kiddos participating. Not limited to families; a group of young-at-heart neighbors are also welcomed to plan a *Compassion in Action Campfire*.
